OPEN HOUSE

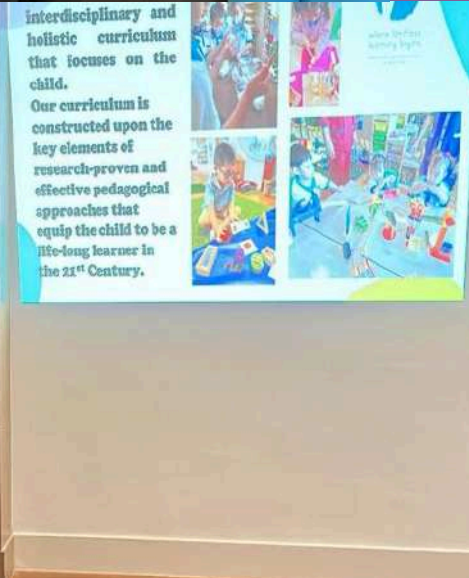
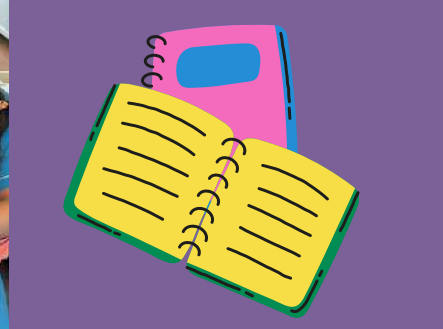

FIRE AND EARTHQUAKE DRILL

This Term 2, one of our school's Key Performance Indicators (KPI) was to introduce the Safety Plan to the children through Fire Drill and Earthquake Drill simulations. During Week 6, we focused on helping the children understand the importance of safety and how to respond during emergency situations. From Monday to Tuesday, each class discussed what fire and earthquake are, and how to stay safe during such incidents.

On Wednesday, we gathered in the gym area to watch a demonstration on safety practices during fire and earthquake situations. The children showed great interest and curiosity while learning about the steps to take to protect themselves.

The Fire Drill was conducted on Thursday at 9:30 a.m. The school alarm was sounded to signal a simulated fire emergency. The children responded calmly and confidently — following the safety rules and moving quickly to the assembly point outside the school. Each class and childcare group were accounted for by the classroom teachers to ensure everyone had evacuated safely.

The Earthquake Drill was conducted on Friday at 9:30 a.m. The school alarm was sounded to signal a simulated earthquake emergency. The children followed the safety steps—Drop, Cover, and Hold—by taking cover under their tables. When the second alarm was sounded, it signalled that the earthquake had stopped and it was time to evacuate. The children lined up and gathered at the assembly point smoothly and safely.

We are proud to share that both drills ran smoothly and successfully. The children demonstrated strong awareness, cooperation, and understanding of safety procedures.

We believe that through these experiences, our students will continue to build lifelong awareness and responsibility toward their own safety and the safety of others.

Puppet Training

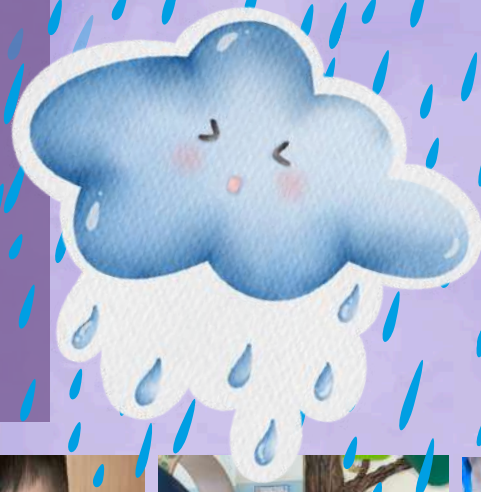
